To whom it may concern:

The Solicitation of Contributions Act set forth in Chapter 496.401 of the Florida Statutes, does not apply to the University of Miami.

Specifically, Section 496.403 provides:

“496.403 Application.—Sections 496.401-496.424 do not apply to bona fide religious institutions, educational institutions, and state agencies or other government entities or persons or organizations who solicit or act as professional fundraising consultants solely on their behalf.”

Therefore, the University of Miami is not registered with Florida’s Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services.
